Why is Mozambique a major energy exporter?

Mozambique is a net exporter of energy to countries in the Southern African Power Pool (SAPP) - South Africa being the largest importer. The government view energy exports as a key driver of the Mozambican economy, having passed a new electricity law that simplifies permitting and encourages IPPs activities.

How will Mozambique improve electricity supply?

These figures drop to 15% and 1% in rural regions. Mozambique aims to extend electricity supply through a mix of grid-connections, mini-grids, and solar home systems, and cleaner cooking through liquified petroleum gas (LPG), improved biomass stoves, and electric cookers.

1.1 Natural Gas Reserves Mozambique is home to some of the largest natural gas reserves in the world, primarily located in the Rovuma Basin. These reserves have the potential to transform Mozambique into a major global player in the energy markets. Initial estimates suggest that the basin holds over 100 trillion cubic feet of natural gas.
